Becoming a great RN begins by learning the basics of day-to-day safe practice in a supportive learning environment. At Durham Regional Hospital, you will receive the personal touch that only a community hospital setting can provide. You will work within the scope of practice of a Nursing Care Assistant II (PNA II) while learning the clinical skills, critical thinking and communication techniques important to the RN scope of practice. Your experience will include:

- 10 weeks of 8 hour or 12 rotating shifts. You will work full time directly with a RN on an assigned unit. You will hone your organizational skills while you gain experience with patient care. At the end of the 10-week period, you may elect to continue to work as a Nursing Assistant on an assigned unit or in the float pool.
- Class time focusing on the assessment skills, communication skills and patient advocacy as well as opportunities to network with other PNAs.
- An 8 hour shadowing experience in an area of choice arranged by unit leadership.
